

Esperanza Bautista Parejo



Esperanza Bautista Parejo left us on December 20, 2016, after five days at hospital. Since Ignacio's death, her husband, with whom she was very close, she had her eyes fixed on heaven, where they are now united again in the embrace of God.

Esperanza holds a degree in Law (UCM), a degree in Theology (UPC) and a Master's Degree in Bioethics (UPC), a Diploma in a Course on «L'Influence des Communautés Européennes sur le Droit International Privé des États Membres»,

Institut Universitaire International Luxembourg, (Center Internationale d'Études Juridiques et de Droit Comparé).

She had practiced law (ex officio, and private), which she abandoned in favour of teaching. She was a professor at the Universidad Pontificia de Comillas and at EFETA, [the School of Feminist Theology of Andalusia] (History of Feminist Theology and Mariology). She organized various seminars and participated in numerous courses and conferences on Feminist Theology, Feminism, Ecumenism and Ethics, in which she always left a good memory, due to her academic level and dedication to her students. Her legal knowledge helped her to interpret many elements of theology and the history of women in the early Church.

Member of the Women's Studies Forum (WEF) and the Ecumenical Forum of European Christian Women (EFECW). Founder and member of the Association of Spanish Theologians (ATE). Member of the European Society of Women in Theological Research (ESWTR) of which she was a contact woman for Spain until 2011. She was also a member of the "José de Acosta" Interdisciplinary Association (ASINJA) and the (EFETA).
